We are looking for individuals who are excited about teaching Outdoor Education classes, leading field trips for local students; and working with a close-knit team.

Job Responsibilities

Mountain Roots' Outdoor Education Instructors work with a range of local schools and maintain a wide range of **responsibilities**; these include, but are not limited to the following:

- Facilitate Outdoor Education programs as assigned (Dates / calendars will be provided)
- Assist with the development of successful Outdoor Education programs
- Attend and be engaged at Mountain Roots staff meetings and trainings
- Attend Mountain Roots community events (as your schedule allows)
- Act as a positive example for our participants
- Manage groups in a safe manner, as outlined in the Mountain Roots risk management plan
- Physically able to work the various programs
- Various non-teaching responsibilities and projects as assigned

Qualifications

- Bachelor's degree in environmental sciences/studies, outdoor leadership/recreation/education; elementary education, and other related fields (Or equivalent work experience)
- Experience working with youth & individuals from various backgrounds
- Competent and comfortable leadership and facilitation styles
- Excitement about serving others in an outdoor setting through experiential education
- Wilderness First Aid / CPR
- Interest in expanding facilitation (and other related) skills
- Must pass a background check in order to work with our local schools

Compensation

- Facilitation / teaching days: \$144-\$160+ per day (depending on experience)
- Training time = Range: \$15-20/hour (depending on experience)
- OE Instructors are given a Google Sheet work log for keeping track of hours
